Educator's Evaluation Information 09-10

As part of federal requirements for states receiving funding under Phase 2 of the State Fiscal Stabilization Funds Program, all school districts in New Jersey are providing information to the public on the procedures they use to evaluate teachers and principals. The information below will help you understand Califon School District's policies and procedures for evaluating teachers.

Description of the Teacher Evaluation System

Califon School District uses an evaluation model based on Charlotte Danielson's Teacher Evaluation Framework. The framework identifies four critical domains: Planning and Preparation, Classroom Environment, Instruction, and Professional Responsibilities of effective teaching. The district evaluates each educator based on the performance within these domains. This includes classroom observations, walk-throughs, pre and post-conferencing, teacher and student work samples, and other relevant artifacts. Tenured teachers are evaluated once a year, while non-tenured teachers are evaluated three times a year.
